It's noon. Someone opens a full lunch box thanks to Just Food.

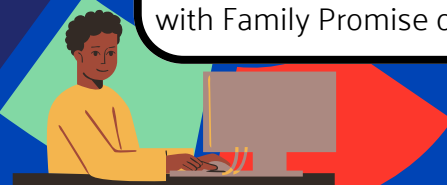
